WHO ARE WE?


Lakeview Church has been active in Saskatoon for 100 years. We are part of the Free Methodist Church, a worldwide movement with historical ties to the abolishment of slavery, early advocation of women's rights, child labour reform and the establishment of hospitals and schools.

Our church community is wonderfully diverse and passionate. We have people of all ages and stages, including many young families with amazing children! Prior to the pandemic, our average attendance at our worship services was approximately 600 people, and we regularly had over 130 children and 30 volunteers in Lakeview Kids each week.

Our staff team is dynamic and loves to laugh together. We currently have 8 staff on our pastoral team, and 6 staff on our Operations and Communications team.

Sunday worship services and Home Church are the central expressions of church life at Lakeview. We value gathering as a collective community, and we also value cultivating deep relationships.

- Invest relationally in the lives of children and their parents.

- Collaborate with Family Formation Pastor to implement curriculum into program strategies.
